Livestock Issues

1. Overnight Accommodation (Cattle)

Attention Hereford and Charolais exhibitors – Please contact relevant breed society regarding overnight accommodation. Due to demand on overnight accommodation, only animals which are booked in and fees paid will be accommodated. Passes will be issued. Accommodation not pre-booked will depend on availability. Strict control of facility will be practised.

All animals must be in place by 9.00pm on 10/08/2019. Late arrivals will not be allowed into the accommodation, due to Department restrictions.

Overnight accommodation can be provided at €20 per animal.

Shed must be vacated by 8.30am on the morning of the Show. Exhibitors whose animals remain in the overnight shed after 8.30am on Show Day will forfeit their prizemoney, if awarded.

2. Pre-movement test is not required, but recommended.
3. Compliance certs will be required for the movement of cattle.
4. Animals should be safely led by a competent handler.
5. All bovines must be correctly tagged. If plastic, both tags must be inserted in the animal. Documents and animals must be correct and will be inspected by Department of Agriculture officers before entry will be allowed.
6. Bibs to display exhibit numbers will be available to purchase on site.
7. Exhibitors should have insurance on all their animals.
8. Exhibitors erecting Gazebo's are responsible for their secure erection and stability at all times.
